Emphasis laid on Tai language in view of 'Act East Policy'

SIBSAGAR, March 6: On the occasion of opening of a study centre in memory of Chongling Su-Ka-Pu on the Sibsagar Girls' College premises on Thursday, noted artist, critic, novelist, researcher, and film director Dr Prabha Goswami delivered a speech on 'The Tai of the Northeast India'.

Dr Goswami said that the study of the Tai language is very important as it connects many South East Asian countries and can serve as a link language in view of today's 'Act East Policy'. He said that the subject of Tai studies has already been introduced in many universities in Germany, the US, Australia, and England. Dr Suraj Kumar

Barman, he said, first took active steps to translate various Tai Aham scripts into Assamese. He mentioned that Goling Chandra Baruah of Jorhat first translated the 'Tai Buranji' into Assamese, adding that Tai words are found in all South East Asian languages.

Dr Goswami said that William Clifton Doidge, a US linguist, first made a scientific study of the Tai language and culture by spending many years among the tribes of Assam.

Dr Goswami used slides to show the Tai people's migratory route from Mong Mao in present-day Yunnan province of China to Assam in the 13th century. Dr Goswami said that the Tai enriched the Assamese language and over

3,000 Tai words are found in the Assamese vocabulary. The Aham broke down many Sanskrit words into simple Assamese words, he added.

Dr Goswami asserted that the Srimanta Sankardev's thought is against the tribal elements

here from the present-day Yunnan province to Assam through the Patkai hills.

Noted writer Prem The Gohain, who is presently working on a Tai Phonetic language (sound) dictionary project in Sibsagar University, said that the new study centre in Sibsagar Girls' College will be a hub of scholars on the languages of the Tai and other NE tribes. He added that the centre should preserve the important resources and information on ethnic, cultural, elements, songs, rhymes, and other relics before they perish in the flux of time.

The meeting was presided over by outgoing president Nilakanta Goswami.
